8. One Bloom **Daffodil** Division Six
9. One Stem **Daffodil** Division Five
10. One Stem **Daffodil** Division Seven or Eight

One Pot

16. Three **Hyacinths**, one cultivar, either blue or mauve
17. Three **Hyacinths**, one cultivar, white
18. Three **Hyacinths**, one cultivar, any other colour (excluding blue, mauve or white)
19. Five **Tulips**, any colour, one cultivar
20. **Daffodils**, Division 1, one cultivar
21. **Daffodils**, Divisions 2 or 3, one cultivar
22. **Daffodils**, Division 4, one cultivar
23. **Daffodils**, Division 6, one cultivar
24. **Daffodils** from Divisions 5, 7, 8, 10, 11 or 12 except miniatures
25. **Daffodils**, Miniature, species or hybrids, one cultivar
26. **Daffodils** Division 13, species or natural hybrids

27. One Bloom **Daffodil**, Division One

Virtual Show Regulations

- 4) **Cultivars should be named and the class for each picture submitted must be clear.**
- 5) **Please ensure you submit only three pictures per email (unless in a zip file).**
- 6) Photographs not according to Schedule will **not** be included in the final show.
