Alpine Plants, Woodland Plants and spring bulbs (excluding Daffodils, Hyacinths or Tulips)

- 2.1 **Chionodoxa**
- 2.2 **Scilla**
- 2.3 **Muscari**
- 2.4 **Fritillaria**
- 2.5 **Erythronium** (Dog's Tooth Violet)
- 2.6 **Corydalis**
- 2.7 **Any other alpine or woodland Bulb, Corm or Tuber** (*excluding Daffodils, Hyacinths or Tulips*)
- 2.8 **Saxifraga**
- 2.9 **Sempervivum, Sedum** or other hardy succulent
- 2.10 **Cushion Plant**
- 2.11 **Rock Plant** for foliage effect
- 2.12 **Primula** Alpine (eg P. allionii)
- 2.13 **Primula** Border (eg primrose and polyanthus)
- 2.14 **Primula** Asiatic (eg P. denticulata)
- 2.15 **Ranunculaceae: Anemone, Hepatica, Helleborus**
- 2.16 **Any other alpine or woodland plant excluding bulbs**

- 1) Entering to the virtual show is open to all - members and non-members. **Photographs should be taken between 3rd and 9th of April 2021.**
- 2) All exhibits must have been grown by the Exhibitor.
- 3) A competitor may enter up to **two** exhibits in any one Class.
- 4) **Cultivars should be named and the class for each picture submitted must be clear.**
- 5) Submitting a photograph is no guarantee that it can be included. Only images submitted by email will be used.
- 6) Photographs not according to Schedule will **not** be included in the final show.
- 7) Photographs should be submitted to springshow@rchs.co.uk by **Friday 9th April** with your name and note of the class or classes you are entering.
