#### Section 1 Auriculas

*Pot size to be no more than 3-4in/ 9-12cm* diameter.

- 1. One plant Show Auricula, alpine
- 2. One plant Show Auricula, edged
- 3. One plant Show Auricula, self
- 4. One plant Show Auricula, fancy edged
- 5. One plant Show Auricula, fancy other than edged
- 6. One plant Show Auricula, striped
- 7. One plant Auricula, double
- 8. One plant Border Auricula
- 9. Novice class One Auricula any type
- 10. A collection of 3 Auriculas, One plant per pot any type, at least two cultivars.
- 11. A collection of 3 Auriculas, One plant per pot any type, all the same cultivar.
- 12. A collection of 6 Auriculas, One plant per pot, any type, at least three cultivars.
- 13. Seedling Auricula class any type.

#### Section 2 Other Primula Species & Hybrids

Pot size to be in scale with the plant but not to exceed 12in/30cm in diameter.

- 14. Novice class One plant species or sub species.
- 15. Novice class Two plants, species or sub species different & distinct.
- 16. One pot Primula native to Scotland.
- 17. One pot Primula native to the British Isles.
- 18. One pot Primula native to Europe or America.
- 19. One pot Primula native to Asia.
- 20. A collection of 4 Primula species or sub species.
- 21. One pot Primula double.
- 22. One pot primrose or polyanthus jack in the green, hose in hose or jackanapes
- 23. Collection of 6 Primrose or Polyanthus, all different.
- 24. Novice class One pot Primrose.
- 25. Novice class One pot Polyanthus.
- 26. One pot Gold or Silver Laced Polyanthus.

#### Notes for entrants:

#### General

- Entry is open to all Members and Non-members in all classes.
- Staging is from 9:00 to 11:00 am on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> May
- We allow **two** entries per class from entrants, whether novice or experienced.
- Staging cards will be provided and should be placed face down beside the entry
- Judging will take place between 11:00 and 12:00
- Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring the removal of their own exhibits after the show closes at 4:00pm

#### Section 1 - Auriculas

- Pots should be no more than 3-4in/ 9-12cm and can be plastic or clay.
- Plants should ideally be shown as single plants.


#### Section 2 – Primulas

- The pot size should be in scale with the plant but not exceed 12"/30cm in diameter
- A pot can have more than one plant but they must be the same species or variety
- You can lift plants from your garden to be shown in pots.

Turn into Stevenson Avenue and follow the road round.
