**Cacti Classes**

- 1 Collection of Six different cacti (max pot size 18cm)\* *\*see note 1*
- 2 One plant **Mammillaria** group
- 3 One plant **Rebutia** group
- 4 One plant **Cereus** group
- 5 One plant **Gymnocalycium** group
- 6 One plant **Parodia** group
- 7 One plant **Echinopsis** group
- 8 One plant **Echinocactus** group
- 9 One plant any **cactus** in flower \*\* *\*\*see note 2*
- 10 One plant any **cactus** (excluding classes 2-8)

## Succulent Classes

- 11 Collection of Six different Succulents (max pot size 18cm)\* *\*see note 1*
- 12 One plant **Agave** group
- 13 One plant **Aeonium** sub-group or **Sempervivum** sub-group
- 14 One plant **Echeveria** sub-group
- 15 One plant **Crassula** sub-group or **Adromischus** sub-group or **Sedum** sub-group
- 16 One plant **Euphorbia** group
- 17 One plant **Aloe** group or **Gasteria** group or **Haworthia** group
- 18 One plant **Mesembryanthemum** group
- 19 One plant any **succulent** in flower \*\* *\*\* see note 2*
- 20 One plant any **succulent** (excluding classes 12 – 18)
- 21 NOVICE CLASS – one plant cactus *\*\*\*see note 3*
- 22 NOVICE CLASS – one plant succulent
- 23 Display of **cacti and/or succulents** in a container not exceeding 45cm

### NOTES:

- Note 1:** Classes 1 and 11 will be judged as general classes with up to an additional 4 points being available to reflect variability and diversity of the exhibit.
- Note 2:** Classes 9 and 19 for plants in flower up to 10 points will be available for flowers and 10 for condition and maturity.
- Note 3:** Classes 21 and 22 - a **NOVICE** is an entrant who has not previously scored more than 10 points in show classes for cacti or other succulents.

- There are no pot size restrictions except where stated
- Maximum of **two** entries per class other than classes 1,11 and 23 when only one entry is permitted.
- Exhibits/Entries should be named where possible.
- The show will be judged in accordance with the BCSS Handbook of Shows, 11<sup>th</sup> Edition. [www.bcss.org.uk](http://www.bcss.org.uk)

### From Gorgie Road

Turn off Gorgie Road into Stenhouse Drive (at the Pure Gym building).

Turn right Stenhouse Crescent. At the end of the road turn right. you will see a signpost for Sports complex. Follow the road round.

### From Stevenson Road/Balgreen Road

Turn into Stevenson Avenue and follow the road round.
